It was decided that the Council may examine the clause 8(4) of AICTE's norms and guidelines for fees and guidelines for admissions in professional colleges, GSR 476(E) dated May 20, 1994, for any incompatibility purported to have crept in between the Supreme Court Judgement of Unnikrishnan versus Others-1993 and clause 8(4) referred to above. If clause 8(4) is in contravention of Supreme Court direction, then action would be taken to get clause 8(4) deleted.
